### \*Upcoming Service Order Deadlines\*

With IDS Vancouver only weeks away, we STRONGLY recommend that all exhibitors place their service orders as soon as possible. The pre-show order deadline for the services listed below is **Tuesday, September 13**; after that time the VCC Exhibitor Order Portal will be closed to advance orders. Any service orders placed onsite will be subject to significantly higher fees, limited options and delayed installation. If your booth requires electrical, lighting, rigging or any of the services listed below, **now is the time to place your orders!** 

Please note: if you have a floor port within the footprint of your booth, you are still required to order electrical services in order to access power from that port.

## **Move-In Times & Voyage Control**

Voyage Control is the online loading dock reservation system used by Vancouver Convention Centre. Emails will be sent out this week with a link and instructions on how to book your timeslot for move-in. Please check the colour-coded move-in floorplan for your assigned move-in time (this is the time during which you should book your Voyage Control timeslot). VCC off-loading areas will not be available for deliveries outside of your scheduled move-in times, however, booth displays can be worked on following your assigned offloading time. ## **Occupational Health & Safety**

NEW THIS YEAR: The Vancouver Convention Centre will no longer be providing complimentary high-visibility vests. Please bring safety vests for your entire team or be prepared to purchase them onsite.

Anyone working or visiting the show floor during move-in and move-out, regardless of their booth size or location on the show floor, MUST wear the following:

- High visibility vest. NEW THIS YEAR: The VCC will no longer be providing complimentary high-visibility vests. Safety vests are available to purchase at the Service Desk on the show floor or on through the VCC Exhibitor Portal; you are also more than welcome to bring your own safety vests.
- CSA approved steel-toed safety shoes (look for the green triangular patch).
